Northbound on I-5:

Take Exit 21—Woodland / Cougar.
Turn right at the end of the off ramp onto
Lewis River Road, and then *immediately*
turn right again at CC Street (the light).

Or, Southbound on I-5:

Take Exit 21—Woodland / Cougar.
The road will run south, parallel to freeway,
until you come to T intersection at Lewis
River Road. Turn left and follow the signs
for 503 to Cougar. Go under the freeway
and turn right at the first light after the
southbound off ramp, CC Street and sign
says to La Center.

Cell Phones do not work well east of
Woodland. So if you need to call, do so
before you get very far out of town.

THEN:

This will take you south across the Lewis
River bridge. As you clear the bridge bear
left at the Y onto NW Hayes Road. If you
are not on the south side of the river, you
missed the turn. Go about 4.5 miles and turn
right (south) on 12th Avenue after the road
goes up a sharp hill. After about another
mile you will come to of a chain link pasture
fence on the right. Turn right onto a gravel
driveway at the south end of this fence. We
are the first house on the right. Park
anywhere.
