Smaller in stature yet heavily fleeced with great DENSITY and very crimped BUNDLED LOCK structure. The structure is so unique the judge in his first show encouraged everyone including the other judges to inspect him. The 2014 shearing produced 7 lbs with a blanket of 3 1/2 inch average staple. Manageable with a very mellow temperament. Awarded FIVE 1st PLACE and TWICE COLOR CHAMPION in his outings!

MOONRAKER

MoonRaker is a TRUE BLACK son of VICTOR's JULIUS & PATAGONIA's COMPADRE daughter, Moonshadow. He continues to produce beautiful fleece with bold

crimp with soft buttery feel on a compact correct confirmation. Two 1st place and 3 seconds in his 2008-10 shows always commended his fleece. Breed now at \$500.

White Oak's Maximus has a sensational MELLOW temperament combined with excellent conformation on a compact frame. His fleece shows more ROSEY TONES as he matures adding to its soft hand with over 4 inch staple in his fourth blanket. If you like a weighted Peruvian background he is one to take a closer look and breed at \$800.
